

STATEMENT ON EVIDENCE

East Quarter Corner of Section 25, Township 145 North, Range 31 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

In 1873, P.H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, set a wood post in place to mark the location of East Quarter corner and established bearing trees as follows: a 4" Poplar, S40°W 440 links; a 6" White Pine, S11°E 570 links.

In 1933, W. W. Bandy, United States Surveyor, made a dependent resurvey of part of the east boundary of Township 145 North, Range 31 West and set a 1" dia. x 36" iron post with brass cap by proportionate distance, and recorded a new BTs: a 10" Norway Pine, N0°15'W 411 links; a 26" Norway Pine, S58 3/4°W 437 links. Information on file in the Cass County Surveyors office.

On March 14, 2011, a Northern Engineering & Consulting survey crew found a "G.L.O." brass cap monument down in the wetland 4" in good condition. Found brass cap accepted as re-established by the GLO in 1933.
