STATEMENT ON EVIDENCE

Northeast Corner of Section 13, Township 143 North, Range 29 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

In 1873, P.H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, set a wood post inplace to mark the location of this corner and established bearing trees as follows: a 6" Tamarack, S20°W 27 links; a 7" Tamarack, S4°E 31 links; a 5" Tamarack, N40°E 22 links; and a 4" Black Ash, N27°W 16 links.

In 1918, Albinus N. Kimmell, U.S. Cadastral Engineer, set a 2x36" iron pipe with a brass cap proportionally. No bearing trees were established but he noted that they dug pits in each section 3' distance and scattered the earth. Information on file in the Cass County Surveyors office.

In June 2011, a Northern Engineering & Consulting survey crew found a 2" iron pipe with a 2.5" diameter G.L.O. brass cap leaning 45° under the surface of the water, they placed in an upright position. No objects near for ties. Found brass cap monument is accepted as position established by GLO in 1918.
