- 1960 An Affidavit As To Location Of Government Corner, signed by Peter Meyer, Licensed Surveyor, No. 3628, states the above described information from 1958. Recorded in the Office of Register of Deeds, Cass County.
- 2003 Itasca County Survey Department personnel, Robertson and Carlson, found the USFS monument under the ice near the north bank of a creek channel. They straightened up the monument and it checked with a 1958 Elm stump, no other witnesses found. They state the area had been burned in the past. They established new witness as follows:

2011 Personnel from Short Elliott Hendrickson found the 1958 monument. Witnesses found and established as shown on the face of this certificate. An analysis of the record information and field evidence supports this monument as the best evidence of the corner position.
