## AFFIDAVIT AS TO LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

Angle point 3-4
Corner to Sec. 3. T. 141 N. R. 30 W. No. 199

Peter J. Meyer , being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

That I reside at .....Cass Lake ......, Minnesota ....., and am registered as a Land Surveyor under the laws of the State of Minnesota, having Surveyor's Registration Certificate No. 3628

I further depose and say that on the 20th day of February , 1963,

I found the angle point 3-4 corner of Section 3

which was evidenced by the remains of the G.L.O. survey of 1917

Corner was found to be marked by a 1 inch diameter iron post with a brass cap stamped:

S 3 TR | TR 1280 | 1287 AP4 | AP3 1917

and that to perpetuate the location of such corner I did, at the exact location thereof, place a permanent marker consisting of \_\_\_\_\_ no \_new monument set as the G.L.O. brass cap is in good condition.
