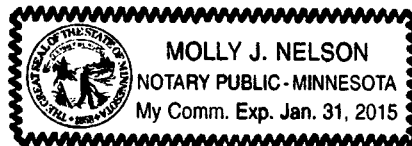

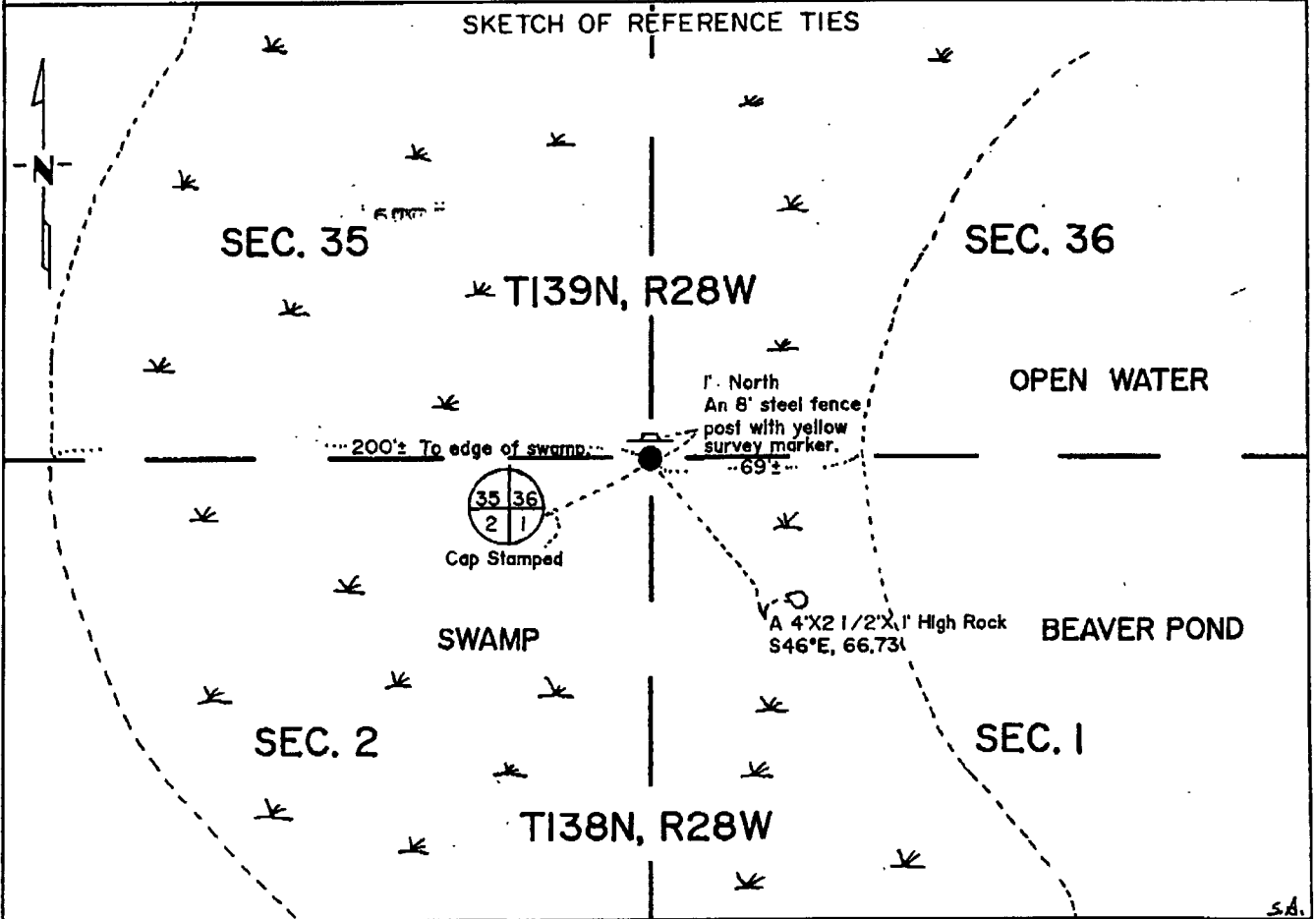

Statement of Evidence:

THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 138 NORTH, RANGE 28 WEST, 5th P.M..

In 1863 the Original Public Land Survey was run. A witness post was set 1.45 chains west to mark the point for the section corner in a pond. A bearing tree to the witness corner was marked. A 16" Yellow Pine, N63W 64 links.

In 1981 David Landecker searched the area but found no evidence of the original or it's accessories.

In December 1989 Tony Kerick, County Surveyor, found a 2½" iron pipe up .3' in a boggy swamp. An 8' steel fence post with yellow survey marker was placed 1' north of the iron pipe and a large rock was referenced as shown on the face of this certificate. This capped pipe is accepted as the section corner. There is no record of this capped pipe in either Cass or Crow Wing county. It is assumed that John W. Curo set this pipe between 1919 and 1922. No Evidence of the original or it's accessories was found.
