Statement of Evidence

East Quarter corner of Section 29, Township 139 North, Range 28 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

- The US General Land Office, in the notes of the subdivision of Township 139 North, Range 29 1864 West set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows: 7" Soft Maple N 23° E 17 links 8" Soft Maple S 80° W 13½ links Said records are on file at the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).
- Ben Clark, RLS 231, Survey Record 434, Book C, Page 305, on file in the CCSO, indicates setting a 1918 Poplar post 3' long and 3" square witnessed by: S 35° E 8" Poplar 19.6' 20" Pine Stump N 60° W 52.2'
- 1919 Ben Clark, RLS 231, Survey Record 434, Book C, Page 337, on file in the CCSO, indicates an IP was set, "so being satisfied that is the true 1/4 S. I set an iron pipe 4 ft. long 21/2 in. diam"
- 1922 Ben Clark RLS 231, Document No. 69796, on file in the CCSO, a county resurvey of sections 27, 28, 33, and 34 indicates an iron monument.
- A KLJ survey crew found a 2 1/2" iron pipe, and is witnessed with the ties shown on the front of this 2012 certificate. Jarrett Leas, RLS #42619, after analysis of record and survey information accepts this monument as the correct perpetuation of the corner.
