

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STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

The North Quarter Corner of Section 5, Township 139 North, Range 30 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

This corner was originally a wood post set by the Government Land Office in 1860.

In 1907, Mr. John Curo, Cass County Surveyor, found a quarter post at the corner.

In 1913, Mr. John Curo, Cass County Surveyor, found a stake at the corner and set a 2"x28" capped iron monument. (Book B of Surveys page 401)

In 1928, the Minnesota State Highway Department found a 2" capped pipe at the road intersection. This is the type of monument Mr. Curo historically set when he replace a wood post.

The notes above were cited on the 1967 Certificate of Location.

In 1967, the Minnesota State Highway Department found a 2" capped pipe at the road intersection and recorded a Certificate of Location under Doc. No. 267939.

In 1981, the Minnesota Department of Transportation recovered the 2" capped pipe. This pipe checks the 1928 alignment calls. The Minnesota Department of Transportation accepted this pipe as a perpetuation of the original Government Corner.

In 1982, the Minnesota Department of Transportation placed a Minnesota Department of Transportation cast iron monument 0.3 below the surface and filed a "Certificate of Location of Government Corner" under Doc. No. A000267939.

On October 30, 2009, a survey crew from Ulteig Engineers found a cast iron monument 4 inches below the road surface, found old ties and set new ties as shown.
