

Statement of Evidence

**East Quarter corner of Section 35, Township 142 North, Range 26 West, 5th Principal Meridian.**

Sept. 5, W.E. Curo, LS 11395, Cass County Surveyor, Certificate of Location of Government Corner, 1986 recorded in the Cass County Recorders office as Instrument Number 291474. The Certificate indicates a 2 inch by 24 inch Galvanized iron pipe with brass cap was set.

Jun. 15, B.Hippen and C.Loe, technicians, records of the CCSO, recovered the 1986 Curo monument and 2000 remains of witnesses which have been cut for power line relocation and added the following new witnesses:

6" Maple	S 88° E	91.55 feet	Power Pole	N 31° E	107.62 feet
8" W Pine	S 47° E	134.45 feet			

May 29, B.Hippen, technician, records of the CCSO, removed the 1986 Curo monument prior to road 2008 construction.

Oct. 1, B.Hippen, technician, records of the CCSO, replaced the 1986 Curo monument which had to be 2008 shortened to 12 inches due to a rock in sub grade, from the 2000 witnesses. The monument is now 3.5 feet, more or less, West of the new centerline of County Road Number 4.

The recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

**Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument established in 1986 by Curo is the accepted location for this corner.**
