

**Index No. 13331G.0-13.0**Statement of Evidence**East Quarter corner Section 9, Township 133 North, Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian.**

- June 1863 T.Walker and W.Smith, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyors set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:
4" Aspen N 71° E 8 links (5.3 feet) 4" Oak S 79° W 12 links (7.9 feet)
Said records are on file with the Secretary of State, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).
- Sept. 1915 E.B.Horst, LS 376, Cass County Deputy Surveyor, Survey Record No.391, Book C, page 86, on file in the CCSO, states " ¼ corner between sections 9 & 10 at station 2652.2 goes E 13.7 ft. I set a 4"x 4"x 48" wood post."
- June 2003 B.Hippen and T.Anderson, technicians, CCSO, notes on file in the CCSO, found a 0.5" pin, 1.4' below road surface, 2' +/- east of centerline of County Road Number 35, 1' +/- south of fence line to west.
- July 2013 B.Hippen, technician, CCSO, records of the CCSO, found monument and witnesses from 2003. The monument, recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by CCSO in 2003 is the accepted location of this corner.
