## Statement of Evidence

North Quarter corner Section 25, Township 134 North, Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

June T.Walker, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyor set a post for the original corner in his subdivision of this township and referenced it as follows:

18" Pine S 50 1/2° E 300 links (198.00 feet) 14" Pine N 88° W 20 links (13.20 feet) Said records are on file at the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).

Feb. D. Cole, LS 1286, Cass County Engineer, CSAH #34, State Project No. 11-634-01, on file in the Cass County Highway Department (CCHD), indicates the subject corner assumed on fence lines North and south at centerline P.O.T. Station 299+77.0.

June J.W. Nielsen, LS 11865, Certificate of Survey, copy on file in the CCSO, indicates a ½ inch pipe was set at the subject corner.

Sept. J. Kramer, LS 23668, Certificate of Survey, copy on file in the CCSO, indicates an iron monument found at the subject corner.

April B.Hippen, technicians, records of the CCSO, found a masonry nail, 1 foot north of centerline CSAH

#34, on fence lines North and South and witnessed as follows:
 4" Juniper N 22° W 61.03 feet R/R Tie Post S 22° E 64.93 feet
 Power Pole N 35° E 60.26 feet

April B.Hippen, CCSO technician and P.Swentkofske, CCHD equipment operator, records of the CCSO, prior to reconstruction of CSAH # 034, excavated a 10 foot east-west by 10 foot north-south area based on record dimensions. The dig was 4 feet deep to natural soil. A 60d spike was found 3 feet below the bituminous. No other evidence was recovered.

May B.Hippen, technician, records of the CCSO, set a Magnetic concrete nail at the position of the PK nail at this location which fit well with the 1998 survey distance, flush, on new centerline.

The recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by CCSO in 2012 is the accepted location of this corner.
