


SKETCH OF REFERENCE TIES

Statement of Evidence

Northeast corner of Section 32, Township 134 North, Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

June 1869 T.Walker, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyor set a post for the original corner in his subdivision of this township and referenced it as follows:
6" Spruce N 27° W 12 links (7.9 feet) 18" Spruce N 60° E 24 links (15.8 feet)
10" Aspen S 31° E 47 links (31.0 feet) 4" Tam S 34° W 37 links (24.4 feet)
Said records are on file at the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).

July 1915 N.D.Gorman, Engineer, Survey Record No. 335, Book B, page 489, on file in the CCSO, states "at 5314.1 corner to secs. 28, 29, 32, 33, lies East 71.10 feet." Measurements East and West are given, then states "at 5308.75 corner to secs. 28, 29, 32, 33, lies south 34 feet."

Oct. 1985 T.Freeman, technician, CCSO, Land Corner Record, on file in the CCSO, states he talked to Jim Ackerson, resident in Section 33. He said that an iron monument had been bladed out. Searched area of P.I. of roads, no Iron.

Sept. 1986 T.Freeman, technician, CCSO, Land Corner Record, on file in the CCSO, indicates a Cast Iron Monument (CIM) was set in the centerline of County Road Number 102 and road to West, 6 feet North of trail to the East. Monument is 6 inches below surface, the following witnesses were established:
Tele Pole N 32° E 61.90 feet Cor Fence Post S 57° E 36.45 feet
Telspar Mon S 45° W 50.20 feet

March 1990 W.Curo, LS 11395, Cass County Surveyor, filed a Certificate of Location of Government Corner, on file in the Cass County Recorders Office and the CCSO, pertaining to the 1986 data, as Document Number 319105.

March 2001 B.Hippen and C.Loe, technicians, CCSO, notes on file in the CCSO, found the CIM, down 0.3 foot, 3 feet, more or less East of centerline of County Road Number 102.

July 2013 B.Hippen, CCSO technician, records of the CCSO, found the monument and witnesses from 2001. The monument, recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by CCSO in 2001 is the accepted location of this corner.
