

Statement of Evidence

**North Quarter corner of Section 1, Township 139 North, Range 25 West, 5th Principal Meridian.**

1863    The US General Land Office, in notes of the subdivision of Township 139 North, Range 25 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:  
15" W.Pine      S 15° W                  6 links                                  10" Tamarack      N 56° W                  26 links

Said records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).

2013    KLJ field crews searched the area and find no evidence of the corner or accessories. This corner was set at a single proportion between the NW 1 and NE 1. A 5/8" x 48" rebar with plastic cap stamped "Leas MN 42619" was set to mark the corner position no witness ties were available to witness the corner. Jarrett Leas, RLS #42619, after analysis of record and survey information accepts this monument as the correct perpetuation of the corner.
