





Statement of Evidence

**North Quarter corner of Section 21, Township 139 North, Range 26 West, 5th Principal Meridian.**

- 1863    The US General Land Office, in notes of the subdivision of Township 139 North, Range 26 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:  
24" W. Pine    N 85° W                      334 links                      20" N. Pine            S 88° W    460 links  
Said records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).
- 1936    The CCC Washburn Lake field book 3, page 32, on file at the DNR office in Brainerd, indicates finding a scribed square stake in a swamp 8 chains south of a road, and the Northeast corner of Section 21 is 47.7 chains to the east.
- 1937    The CCC Washburn Lake field book 8, on file at the DNR office in Brainerd, indicates both GLO BT's were found and a 1 ½"x54" iron pipe with a 2 ½" cap was set 2 ½' in the ground and referenced by the following:  
6 ¾" Tamarack            S 62° W                      38.6'                      5 ¾" Tamarack            N 38° W    51.5'
- 1938    The CCC Washburn Lake field book 20, page 41, on file at the DNR office in Brainerd, indicates the subject corner to be 518' south of Camp Road.
- 1964    The Cass County Highway Department found a 2" iron pipe in place 494' south of County Road #48.
- 1967    The MN DNR Engineering Division found a 1 ½" iron pipe with a brass cap in place.
- 2013    KLJ field crews searched the area and find no evidence of the corner or accessories. This corner was set lost by single proportion between the NE 21 and the NE 20. A 5/8" x 48" rebar with plastic cap stamped "Leas MN 42619" was set to mark the corner position and is witnessed with the ties shown on the front of this certificate. Jarrett Leas, RLS #42619, after analysis of record and survey information accepts this monument as the correct perpetuation of the corner.
