## Statement of Evidence

## Northeast corner of Section 28, Township 139 North, Range 26 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

The US General Land Office, in notes of the subdivision of Township 139 North, Range 26 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:

6" Bl. Oak N 74° E 22 links 6" Bl. Oak S 62°30' E 13 links 6" Bl. Oak S 16° W 14 links 24" W. Pine N 57° W 6 links

Said records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).

1910 A.W. Moulster, Deputy County Surveyor, Curo field book 48\_1, page 72-73, indicates an old pine stub and a 2 ½"x 2 ½" rotten Birch stake marked 21-22-27-28 was found.

A.W. Moulster, Deputy County Surveyor, Curo field book 48\_1, page 77-78, indicates a wood post was set, stating, "at 5715.5 feet cor 21-22-27-28 sits south 113.75 feet. I set a 3 ½"x3 ½"x 2 ½' post marked 21-22-27-28. Old BT set as follows WP stub 24 N54 W 4 feet". Three new bearing trees were established as follows:

24" W. Pine stub S 15°55' E 75.75 feet 24" W. Pine stub N 81° E 38.2 feet

24" W. Pine stub S 15°55' E 75.75 feet W. Pine stump S 45°45' W 95.8 feet

A KLJ survey crew found a rebar with an aluminum cap stamped "RLS 13336", and is witnessed with the found ties shown on the front of this certificate. Jarrett Leas, RLS #42619, after analysis of record and survey information accepts this monument as the correct perpetuation of the corner.
