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## STATEMENT ON EVIDENCE

East Quarter Corner of Section 24, Township 139 North, Range 26 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

In 1863, Johnson and Thornton, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, running the east line of the township, set a wood post inplace to mark the location of this corner and established bearing trees as follows: a 13" White Pine, N84°E 32 links; and a 7" Yellow Birch, S43°W 39 links.

In 1937, Approximate corner was set by the C.C.C. Information on file in Washburn Lake - Book #2, Page 7.

In 1957, The plat of Bannister's Lake Leavitt Addition by Elmore M. Wilsie shows the location of this corner.

On October 29, 2013, a Northern Engineering & Consulting, Inc. survey crew found a 1/2" iron pipe, 2" above surface grade. A metal T-post was found marking its location 0.2 feet southwesterly of the iron pipe. Two new ties were set as shown on the front of this certificate. The 1/2" iron pipe monument was accepted as the perpetuation of this corner.
