## STATEMENT ON EVIDENCE

East Quarter Corner of Section 23, Township 139 North, Range 26 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

In 1863, Johnson and Thornton, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, running subdivision lines, set a wood post inplace to mark the location of this corner and established bearing trees as follows: a 20" White Pine, S70°W 30 links; and a 24" White Pine, N22°E 43 links.

**In 1916,** John Curo, Cass County Surveyor, set a 2"x48" iron boiler pipe proportionally. Information in Cass County Survey Department, in Record Book B, Pages 191-194.

In March 2008, a Northstar Surveying survey crew searches for the corner and finds nothing. Northstar determines the corner had been perpetuated by B.H. Bradly in the plat of Tingdale Bros. Lake Roosevelt Shores and uses irons in the plat to establish for the corner. Northstar sets a 1/2" inside diameter pipe with a cap stamped 24332 and establishes 2 accessories. A punch hole in easterly end of a 12" culvert 116.00 feet from the iron and another punch hole in the westerly end of culvert 115.44 feet from the iron. A 1/2" pinch top iron was also found to the west 36.18 feet. The corner was set approximately 8 feet westerly from the centerline of a north-south trail.

On October 29, 2013, a Northern Engineering & Consulting, Inc. survey crew found a 1/2" iron pipe with a cap stamped RLS 24332 as set by Northstar Surveying and accepts the corner as established by them from obliterated methods.
