


STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE: Standard Corner common to Sections 33 and 34 of Township 145 North,
Range 26 West of the 5th Principal Meridian

1871; George Stuntz, for the Government Land Office, this corner location in the reed bottoms of the Mississippi River, set a witness corner 4.79 chains westerly witness by:

Aspen 6" South 4^o West, 44 Links
Aspen 6" South 58^o West, 37 Links

1876; Benjamin Baldwin, Government Land Office commenced his resurvey of the North line of Township 144 N Range 26 W at the witness corner on the west side of marsh being 4.79 chains westerly of the Section corner to Sections 33 & 34 of Township 145 N Range 26 W.

1900; U.S. Army Corps of Engineers recovered the witness corner 4.79 chains westerly of the corner location according to Township 145 N Range 28 W flowage map for the Pokegama Reservoir. Map is on file at the USFS office in Cass Lake, MN.

1900; Great Northern Railroad right-of-way, indicates a railroad tie from the Southeast Corner of Section 33 South to the Centerline of Railroad tracks.

1926; State of Minnesota Department of Transportation Right-of-Way Plat No. 1-68 shows two ties from the Southeast Corner of Section 33; 97' North to the Centerline of Road & 371' East to the Northeast Corner of Section 4 of Township 144 North, Range 25 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian.

1946; State of Minnesota Department of Transportation Right-of-Way Plat No. 13-12 shows this corner at the centerline of US Highway No. 2

2010; A Kadrmas, Lee & Jackson survey crew found no evidence at this corner.

2012; Ross Wamre, RLS #45334, set a 3 ½" Brass Cap on a ¾" x 4' rebar flush at the location lost single proportionated measurement location to the Southeast Standard Corner of Section 34 and the South Quarter Corner of Section 33. After review of the Minnesota Department of Transportation Right-of-Way Plat 1-68 and Plat 13-12, the ties shown between these two plats are conflicting therefore they were not considered for restoration of this corner location. Furthermore, when reviewing the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers map the U.S Army Corps' position for this corner is shown northerly & easterly of the existing railroad according to the recovered location of the witness corner. Both the Department of Transportation Right-of-Way Plat No. 1-68 and the Great Northern right-of-way map show the standard corner location south and west of the railroad and do not show that the witness corner was recovered.
