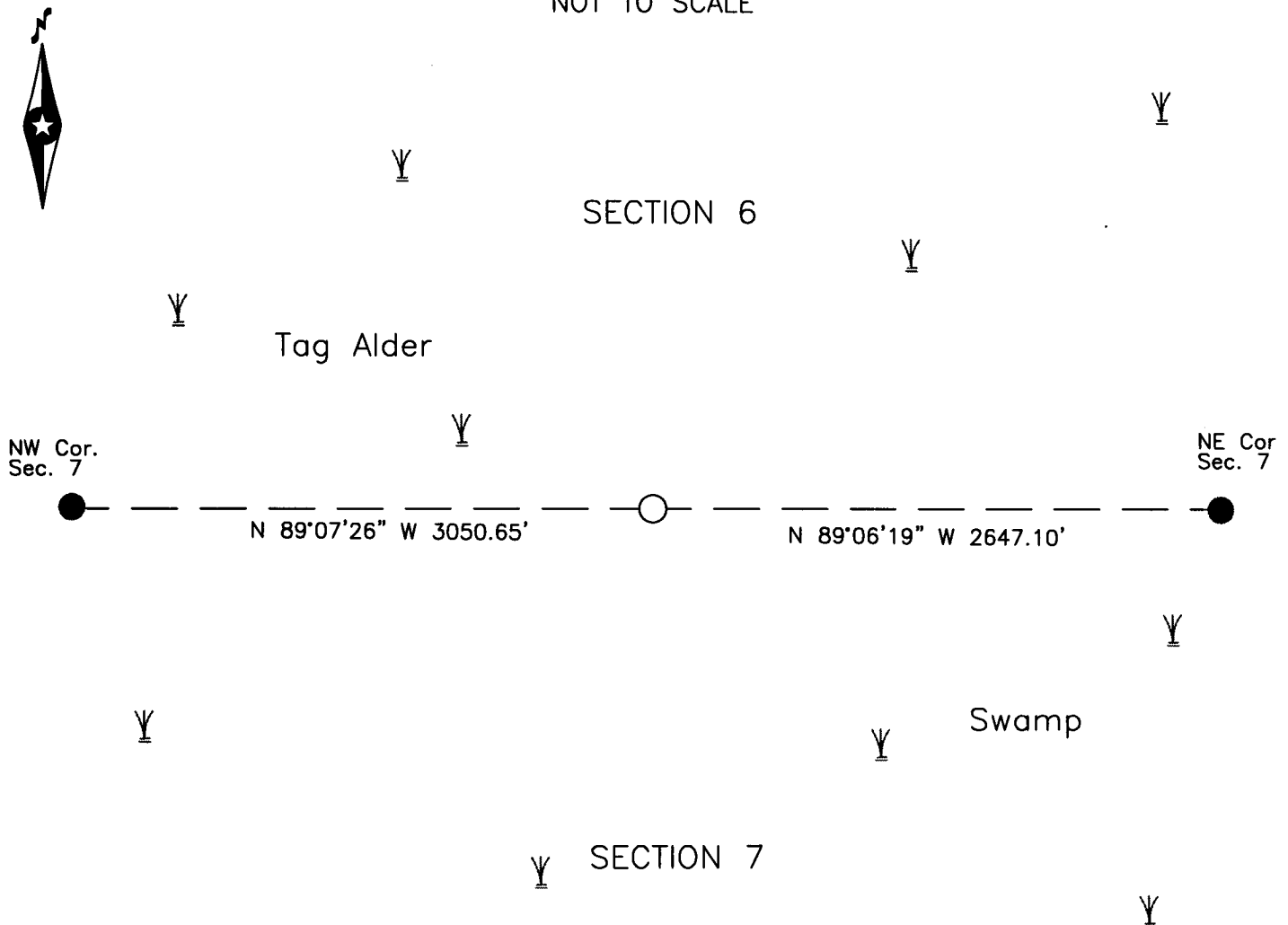

16" Black Ash N 86° W 10 links (6.60 feet) 8" Yellow Birch S 60° E 21 links (13.86 feet)  
Said records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).
- Oct. 1916 E.B. Horst, LS 376, Deputy County Surveyor, survey for a County Road, Record 392, Survey Record Book C, page 91 and Curo Book 96, page 122, on file in the CCHD/SO, states "we set a 2 1/2" by 4 ft capped I.M. at the point being in edge of small creek, No trees near for bearings we set 2 stakes" and follows:  
Stake North 33 feet Stake South 33 feet
- Jan. 2014 B.Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, found 2.5 inch outside diameter iron pipe, down 2 feet, under ice, in open Tag Alder swamp, no trees within 300 feet.

The monument, recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.
