





**STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE:** Quarter Corner common to Sections 14 and 23 of Township 145 North,  
Range 30 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian

**1874;** This corner was originally established by P.H. Conger for the GLO. His field notes indicate a wood post set at this corner position, witnessed by:

Black Pine 8" South 9<sup>o</sup> East, 125 links  
Black Pine 7" North 3<sup>o</sup> West, 187 links

**1918;** USFS 874 Form on file at the USFS office in Cass Lake, MN show the corner consists of a 4" Jack Stake.

**1933;** Resurvey by GLO, Willis W. Bandy, found a tamarack post, 4" square, 4' above ground under grass marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. Set iron post, 3' long, 1" diameter, 28" in the ground with stamped brass cap witnessed by:

Jack Pine stump, North 3<sup>o</sup> West, 187 links - badly weathered (1874 Tie)  
Norway Pine 12" North 48 $\frac{1}{4}$ <sup>o</sup> West, 331 links - mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S14 BT  
White Pine 14" South 64 $\frac{1}{4}$ <sup>o</sup> West, 287 links - mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S23 BT

**1966;** USFS notes of Township 145 North, Range 30 West, Book 1, Page 70, on file at the USFS office in Cass Lake, MN show James Ebstrom, USFS, found monument in place witnessed by:

Norway Pine 19" North 48<sup>o</sup> West, 218.46' - scribe visible (1933 Tie)  
White Pine 27" South 64<sup>o</sup> West, 189.42' - scribe visible (1933 Tie)  
Jack Pine 7" North 36<sup>o</sup> East, 73.3' - scribed " $\frac{1}{4}$  S14 BT"  
Jack Pine 9" North 83<sup>o</sup> East, 61.3' - scribed " $\frac{1}{4}$  S14 BT"  
72" Steel Sign Post East, 6.3' 54-2 and 54-4 signs attached

**2010;** A Kadrmas, Lee & Jackson survey crew found a 2.5" Brass Cap GLO monument on a 1" Iron Pipe, witnesses found and established as shown on the face of this certificate.

**2012;** Ross Wamre, RLS #45334, after analysis of record and survey information accepts this monument as the correct perpetuation of the corner.
