Statement of Evidence

G.B. Wright, GLO Deputy Surveyor in the notes of the subdivision of Township135 North, Range 29 West, set a June 1865 post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:

21 links (13.86 feet)

The above record is on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).

May J.W. Curo, LS 1428, Curo Book 56, page 131, on file in the CCHD/SO, states "find the stump of the SW old U.S. 1917 bearing tree standing not burned and very plainly marked...find the stumps of the others and all check for course and distance. I set an iron section corner being I.M. 2 1/2 x 48 inch boiler tube driven or partly driven in the ground and ice for the true corner" He lists the following references:

1972 Number 206758 indicates an iron pipe monument.

April Landecker and Associates, Inc., sketch of field notes and calculations, on file in the Pequot Lakes office indicates

1982 Ex 2" iron in swamp, west of road 50' +,- and 1939 ties.

T. Freeman, technician and D. Marcum, Cass County forester, Cass County Land Corner Record, on file in the April CCHD/SO, indicates a found 2" x 1.4' I.P. with 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " P.P. inside up 2.0' and the stub of a twin Birch N 68° W 1984

B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, found a 1.25 inch outside diameter iron pipe, up 0.8 foot, inside
