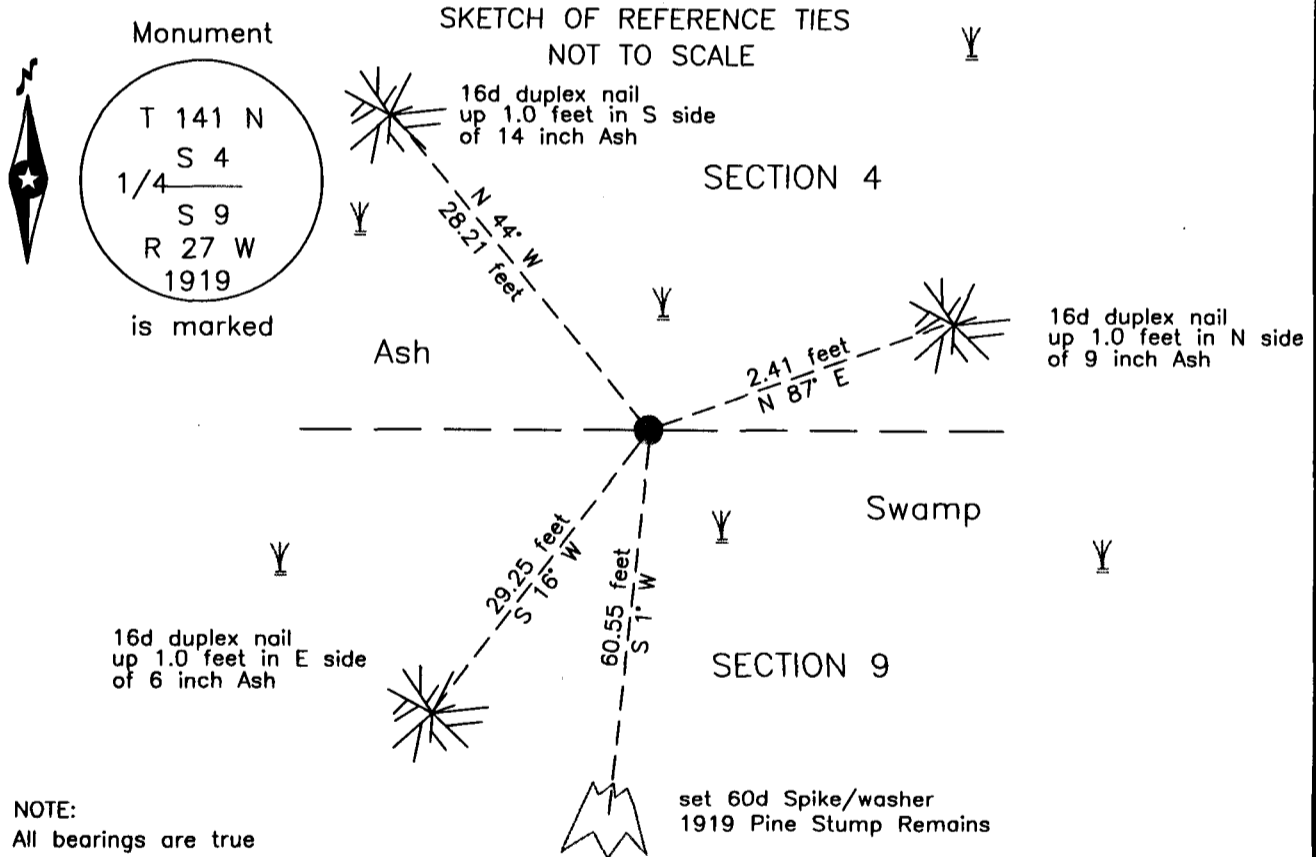

Statement of Evidence

Jan. 1874 P.H. Conger, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyor in the subdivision of Township 141 North, Range 27 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced as follows:  
8" Birch            N 15° W            10 links (6.60 feet)            5" Cedar            North            3 links (1.98 feet)

June 1919 E.G. Harrington, GLO U.S. Cadastral Engineer, in the notes of the reestablishment of a portion of the exteriors and subdivisional lines of this township states "40.50 True proportional point for the ¼ sec. cor., unable to find any evidence of the original post or bearing trees. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. In the ground, with brass cap"... "No tree suitable for a north bearing tree." The following witness was established:  
12" Norway Pine    S 1°30' W    92 links (60.72 feet)  
Said records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).

July 2006 B. Hippen, technician and E. Lindquist, Cass County Land Department Forester, records of the CCHD/SO, found the GLO 1 inch iron pipe with brass cap, up 1.5 feet in Ash swamp and witnessed it as follows:  
1919 Pine stump            S 1°30' W            60.55 feet to a 60d spike and washer set in the remains  
14" Ash                    N 44° W            28.21 feet            6" Ash            N 87° E            2.41 feet  
6" Ash                    S 16° W            29.25 feet  
The monument, recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

**Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by CCHD/SO in 2006 is the position established by the GLO in 1919 and is the correct perpetuation of this corner.**
