Statement of Evidence

P.H. Conger, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyor in the subdivision of Township 141 North, Range 27 Jan.

1874 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced as follows:

5" Cedar North 3 links (1.98 feet)

N 15° W 10 links (6.60 feet)

June E.G. Harrington, GLO U.S. Cadastral Engineer, in the notes of the reestablishment of a portion of the exteriors

and subdivisional lines of this township states "40.50 True proportional point for the 1/2 sec. cor., unable to find any evidence of the original post or bearing trees. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. In the ground, with

brass cap"... "No tree suitable for a north bearing tree." The following witness was established:

12" Norway Pine S 1°30' W 92 links (60.72 feet)

Said records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass

County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).

July B. Hippen, technician and E. Lindquist, Cass County Land Department Forester, records of the CCHD/SO, found 2006

the GLO 1 inch iron pipe with brass cap, up 1.5 feet in Ash swamp and witnessed it as follows:

1919 Pine stump S 1°30' W 60.55 feet to a 60d spike and washer set in the remains

N 44° W 28.21 feet 6" Ash N 87° E 14" Ash 2.41 feet

6" Ash S 16° W 29.25 feet

The monument, recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by CCHD/SO in 2006 is the position established by the GLO in 1919 and is the correct perpetuation of this corner.
