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## Statement of Evidence

Aug. R. Cronk, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyor set a post for the original corner in his subdivision of this 1870

township and referenced it as follows:

14" Dead N. Pine S 81° E 29 links (19.14 feet) 15" Dead N. Pine N 41° E 42 links (27.72 feet) 18" Dead N. Pine S 76° W 30 links (19.80 feet) N 56° W 8" Dead Spruce 30 links (19.80 feet) Said records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the

Cass County Highway Department Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).

J.M. Canfield, Cass County Surveyor, Road Calendar A, page 81, on file at the CCHD/SO, indicates the Dec. subject corner in Bungo Road. Road Calendar B, page 32, on file at the CCHD/SO, shows the same road. 1898

J.A. Johnston, Survey Record Number 433, Book C, page 284 and Curo Book 80, pages 10 and 30, also Nov. 1915 noted in Curo Book 248, page 8, on file in the CCHD/SO, states "Could not find stone set by Hallet but set small stake to start from, from the four New B.Ts for cor. of 11-12-13-14 which are":

M. Morris, Survey Record Number 489, Book C, page 567 and Curo Book 170B, page 33, on file at the Sept. 1920 CCHD/SO, states "set up at I.M. Cor of 11.12.13.14 run west".

July J.W. Curo, LS 1428, Curo Book 433, page 4, on file in the CCHD/SO, states "IM. In CL road S and S wheel 1940

tract of E & W road. Cap gone." Lists witnesses as follows:

10" J. Pine N 32°54' E 50.95 feet 8" J. Pine N 42°50' W 53 32 feet 16" N. Pine S 56° W 59.30 feet 2 1/4" I.M. S 44°15' E 46.60 feet

J.W. Curo, LS 1428, Survey Record Number 579, Book D, page 259 and Curo Book 248, page 11-13, on file June 1941 in the CCHD/SO, states "We find the green stump of the SW BT SW old spot at base. Find NW NP spot over grown." Also "Dig up 2 x 48" IM-cap torn off with graded – dig down a foot find IM –straight." Then "Old BTs stand perfect for course and distance with Iron" and lists witnesses as follows:

52.70 feet to RR spike driven in center of stump 8" Pine Stump N 11°30' E

Sept. B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, prior to construction on County Road #25 found a 2.25 inch outside diameter iron pipe, down 0.5 foot, 2 feet, more or less, south of centerline of County Road #25 and 2 2014 feet, more or less, east of the centerline of 52nd Avenue and the 2002 witnesses as follows:

18" White Pine (1941) N 40° W 53.88 feet

18" Norway Pine N 18° E 98.36 feet

12" Norway Pine S 28° E 71.02 feet 16" Norway Pine S 29° W 91.05 feet

B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, after construction on County Road #25 reset the 2.25 inch Aug. outside diameter iron pipe, with aluminum cap attached, down 0.05 foot, 2 feet, more or less, south of the new 2015 centerline of County Road #25.

The recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.



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Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument set by CCHD/SO in 2015 is the correct perpetuation of this corner.
