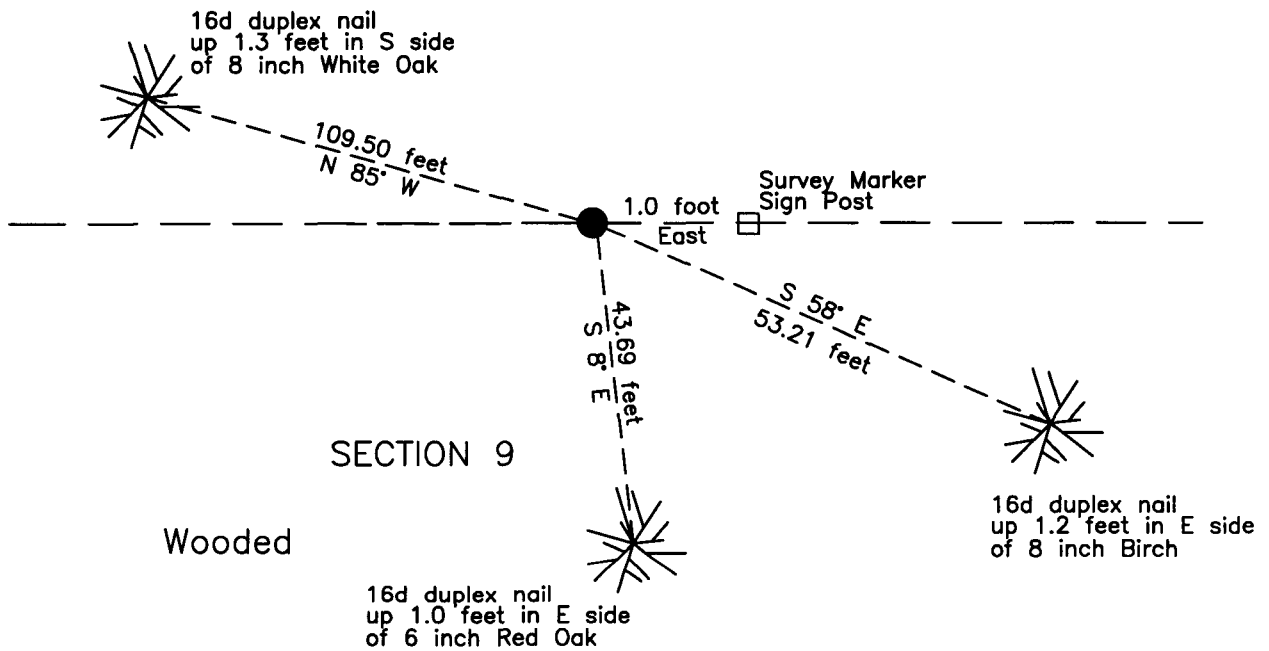
#### SKETCH OF REFERENCE TIES NOT TO SCALE

Statement of Evidence

**North Quarter corner of Section 9, Township 139 North, Range 28 West, 5th Principal Meridian.**

April 1864 Johnson and Thornton, General Land Office Deputy Surveyors, notes for the subdivision of Township 139 North, Range 28 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:

6" Aspen N 35°W 13 links (8.6 feet) 5" Aspen S 10°E 7 links (4.6 feet)

The above record is on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).

Sept. 1919 B. Clark, LS 231, Survey Record No. 434, Book C, page 320, on file in the CCHD/SO, states "set the 1/4 S. bet 4-9 at 2631.8 ft. Equal distance bet the sec. corners an iron pipe 4 ft. long 2 1/2 in diam." and list the following references:

14" W. Pine S 25°E 74.6 feet 12" N. Pine S 40°W 79 feet

Dec. 1921 B. Clark, LS 231, County Resurvey, on file in the Cass County Recorders office, as Document Number 69799, indicates Iron Monument.

July 1999 B. Hippen and C. Loe, technicians, Records of the CCSO, found 2" outside diameter iron pipe, flush with ground and witnessed as follows:

8" White Oak N 85° W 109.50 feet 8" Birch S 58° E 53.21 feet

6" Red Oak S 8° E 43.96 feet Survey Marker East 1.0 foot

The monument, recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

**Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by CCHD/SO is the accepted location of this corner.**
