

**Statement of Evidence:**

**North Quarter corner Section 4, Township 139 North, Range 26 West, 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian.**

November 1863 Gates A. Johnson and Alonzo L Thorton, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyors, notes for the Township 139 North, Range 26 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:

24" White Pine	S 22 degrees E	62 links (40.92 feet)
14" White Pine	N 62 degrees W	21 links (13.86 feet)

The above record is on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyors Office (CCHD/SO).

1938 Civilian Conservation Corp mentioned corner, see Washburn Lake, Book 20, page 40.

April 1987 Walter E. Curo, LS 11395, Cass County Surveyor, Curo Book 315, page 44, on file at CCHD/SO, set the North 1/4 corner based on DMA bearing trees.

4" Red Oak	S 65 degrees W	28.23 feet
10" Red Oak	S 20 degrees E	22.75 feet
(old) 26" Norway Pine	N	83.2 feet
(old) 22" White Pine	NE	52.5 feet

October 2016 Bolton & Menk field crew found a 2 inch square pipe with 3 inch square stamped cap and 3 of the 4 bearing trees from the 1987 Curo Survey. After further analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements the found monument is accepted as the location for this USPLSS corner. Reference ties established for the position are shown on the face of this document (Page 1 of 2).
