

MN Historical Society
Cass County Recorder, Surveyor, and Highway Department
Itasca County Surveyor
US Forest Service Land Department
Contacted Resident Land Owners for permission and testimony

- 1876 The U.S. General Land Office (GLO) field notes, on file with the MN Historical Society, describe this corner as a post from which:
 An Aspen, 16" diam, bears North 85° West, 15 links distant
 An Aspen, 6" diam, bears North 24° East, 31 links distant
- 1900 A survey conducted by the US Corps of Engineers and on file with the Cass County and Itasca County Survey Office, shows no monument symbol at the corner location, but indicates the corner location is north of the Leech Lake River.
- 1939 Air photos, on file with the DNR, show the corner area to be near a northeast-southwest trail road running parallel to the Leech Lake River. No other occupation lines exist.
- 1953 A survey conducted by R.W. Fassett, on behalf of the US Forest Service, indicates a lost position for this corner on his worksheet. No other information is given in his notes. This information is found in USFS Field Book 1 of 144-26, Page 23, in Cass Lake. Copies found in Cass County Surveyor's Office.
- 1970 Curt Krause, Survey Technician from the US Forest Service, states that he chained from the Northwest Corner of Section 23 down to the corner area, but found no evidence of the original corner or any other survey monuments. He does mention that the corner area was farmed in the 1930's. This information is found in USFS Field Book 1 of 144-26, Page 23, in Cass Lake. Copies found in Cass County Surveyor's Office.
- 2016 September, the DNR Survey Unit conducted a search for this corner, but did not find any original evidence of the corner. As a result, this corner position was computed by Single Proportionate Measurement between adjoining section corners north and south. The computed position was found to measure:

2651.17 ft (GLO = 2640 ft) from adjoining section corners

Analysis of the available information led the DNR Land Survey Unit to conclude that the computed position marks the location of the corner. Lack of government corner perpetuation bears out the need for the lost position.
