## West Quarter corner of Section 31, Township 144 North, Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

G.R. Stuntz, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyor, in the notes of the west line of Township 144 North, May

Range 31 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows: 1871

N 25° E 38 links (25.08 feet) 5" Aspen S 55° W 5" Aspen

J.W. Curo, LS 1428, Cass County Surveyor, Wilkinson County Road, Road Calendar Book A, page 58 and Road

Calendar Book B, page 37, indicates the road runs south and east from the subject corner. 1905

Hal D. Craig, U.S. Surveyor, Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of Township 144 North, Range 31 West, found no May 1931 remaining evidence of original post or bearing trees, at proportional distance set a 2 inch by 36 inch iron pipe 38 inches in ground, with brass cap, 2 inches below road surface, at junction of north to south road and road east to

Wilkinson and referenced as follows:

226 links (149.16 feet) 14" W. Pine S 76°45' E N 42°30' W 8" W. Pine The above records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).

J.R. Worcester, Engineer CCHD, Road Plan S.A.P. 11-666-01, on file in the CCHD, found 2 inch iron pipe in Oct.

1976 intersection at station 0+00 for this corner and established three new ties as follows: 6" W. Pine

24" W. Pine SW 82.3 feet 5" Birch NW 150.0 feet

Hubbard County Survey Department, in an unrecorded Certificate of Location of Government Corner, found a June 1981 1 ¼ inch by 2 ½ foot iron pipe, down 0.9 foot in road, removed monument and checked with locater. No other pipe

was found so replaced 1 1/4 inch iron pipe

Hubbard County Survey Department, on an unrecorded Certificate of Location of Government Corner. found the 1986 1 1/4 inch iron pipe still in place and found all the witnesses as established by the CCHD and a pine stump with old blaze faintly visible at the correct bearing and distance for the N.W. 1931 resurvey B.T. They determine the found iron pipe is the 1931 monument and the top 8 inches and brass cap have been taken off, probably by road grader.

D.D. Busker, LS 7203, Hubbard County Surveyor, in unrecorded Certificate of Location of Government Corner, May states "remove the 1 1/4 inch iron pipe and perpetuated it with a 16 inch Hubbard County cast iron monument" and 1991

witnesses as follows:

24" W. Pine(1973) S 65° W 82.30 feet 6" W. Pine(1973) S 84° W 78.90 feet N 57° W 54.86 feet 150.00 feet 5" Birch(1973) Pwr. Pole N 30° F

6" W. Pine S 30° E 123.11 feet

B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, found the 1991 cast iron monument, down 1.0 foot, on centerline May

of CSAH #66, 2 feet, more or less, east of centerline of the Cass Line Road and witnessed as follows:

12" W. Pine(1973) S 84° W 79.12 feet Pwr. Pole(1991) N 30° E 54.86 feet

11" W. Pine(1991) S 30° E N 29° W 123.11 feet **Guy Pole** 64.63 feet

The monument, recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by the CCHD/SO is the accepted location of this corner.
