

STATEMENT ON EVIDENCE

North Quarter Corner of Section 10, Township 137 North, Range 32 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

In 1870, Richard Cronk, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyor, notes of the subdivision of Township 137 North, Range 32 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:

7" Aspen N46°30'E 6 links (3.96 feet)

8" Balsam S17°30'E 20 links (13.2 feet)

The above record is on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).

On November 14, 2018, a Northern Engineering & Consulting (NECI) survey crew searched for evidence of the corner. Finding nothing they set a 1/2" iron pipe with a plastic cap stamped RLS 21367 at the split distance between the found northwest and northeast corners of Section 10.

The monument and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the field evidence and survey measurements indicate that the monument set by NECI is the correct perpetuation of this corner.
