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Statement of Evidence

North Quarter corner of Section 36, Township 143 North, Range 29 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

Oct. A.L. Kimmell, U.S. Cadastral Engineer, GLO, Reestablishment of a Portion of the Exterior and Subdivisional
Lines Township 143 North, Range 29 West, notes page 23, at 40.00 chains(2640.00 feet), set an iron post, 3 feet long, 1 inch diameter, with brass cap, 26 inches In ground, for the corner and notes bearing trees as follows:

8" Elm S 4°45' E 43 links(28.38 feet) 7" Elm S 43 1/2° W 15 links(9.90 feet)

July C.E. Akin, Jr. Cadastral Surveyor, United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management(BLM),
1974 Dependent Resurvey of Portions of the East Boundary and Subdivisional Lines of Section 25, Township 143
North, Range 29 West, notes page 7, state at 22.45 chains(1481.70 feet) from the closing corner for the ¼ line of sec. 25, found an iron post, 1 inch diameter, with brass cap, firmly set, protruding 6 inches, 5 links(3.30 feet), east of graveled road, 25 links(16.50 feet) wide and Kimmell's 1918 witness as follows:

17" Elm S 4-3/4° E 43 links(28.38 feet)

The above records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Highway Department, Surveyor's Office (CCHD/SO).

United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs(BIA), Project No. 132-25, copy on file in the CCHD, indicates a brass cap in place for this corner, on centerline and witnesses as follows:

36" Elm SE 64.0 feet 14" Basswood SW 64.0 feet

Circa R.A. Mustonen, LS 11946, Certificate of Survey of Part of Government Lot 3, copy on file in the CCHD/SO, indicates a monument found at the subject corner.

T.L. Freeman, technician, CCHD/SO and C.R. Krause, technician, United States Department of Agriculture,
Forest Service(USFS), Field Book 1, image 69, on file in the CCHD/SO and Field Book 1, page 21, on file in the
USFS Cass Lake Office, found GLO iron, with brass cap, bent, straighten and field check angles and distances
north and east, 18.4 feet east of centerline Sugar Point Road(County Road #136), in east ditch, on fence line
east. Reset iron flush and surround with rock ring and witnesses as follows:

90.22 feet

17" Elm S 4°45' E 28.38 feet(1918) Alum Cap RM S 60° E 25.20 feet

Dec. T.L. Freeman, LS 21367, Plat of BATTLE POINT ESTATES, on file in the Cass County Recorders Office, as Document Number 420335, indicates brass capped monument found at the subject corner.

June B. Hippen, technician, records of the CCHD/SO, prior to reconstruction of County Road #136, found 2 inch outside diameter iron pipe with GLO brass cap, down 0.2 foot, 18 feet, more or less, east of the centerline of County Road #136, in ditch and witnesses as follows:

8" Red Pine(1985) S 43° W 90.22 feet Alum Cap RM(1985) S 60° E 24.82 feet 8" Ash N 30° E 75.25 feet Power Pole N 39° W 68.68 feet

The monument, together with the recovered and established references for the position are shown on the face of this document.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument recovered by the CCHD/SO is the correct perpetuation of this corner.
