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Statement of Evidence

Northeast corner of Section 13, Township 144 North, Range 26 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

1983 Cass County Highway Department(CCHD), S.P. 11-603-05, on file in the CCHD, plan indicates subject corner assumed at Station 20+81.8.

J. Parker, LS 9235, under contract with the United States Forest Service (USFS), found a 1/2 inch
by 8 inch bolt, down 3.8 feet on the centerline of CSAH #3 and 2 feet more or less north of centerline County
Road #139. He recorded a Certificate of Location of Government Corner in the Cass County Recorders
Office(CCRO) on May 2, 1985 as **Document Number 281679**. The document indicates that the search for this
corner involved personnel of Advance Surveying & Engineering, USFS and Cass County. The bolt was removed
and a 5/8 inch diameter by 36 inch aluminum rod with a stamped 3 inch aluminum cap was set 0.3 foot below the
road surface. The corner was witnessed as follows:
