T.B. Walker, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyers set a post for the original

corner in the subdivision and noted the following accessories.

8" Aspen EAST 5 links 2" Aspen S10W 10 links

Record on file with the Minnesota Historical Society in St. Paul, MN and copies filed with the Cass County County Highway Department, Surveyors Office (CCHD/SO).

Unknown date Walt Curo, RLS 11395, noted the following three Bearing trees, filed in Curo Book 314, page 80.

Record filed with the Cass County County Highway Department, Surveyors Office (CCHD/SO).

2003 Landecker and Associates found this corner in place. This corner was used as a

controlling corner for a double proportioned position for the northeast corner of Section

27.

2020 Lakes Area Surveying searched the area for all previous evidence, finding a 2 inch pipe

with a cap in place. This monument is believed to have been set by Walt Curo. This

was the same monument found and used in the 2003 Landecker survey.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument found by Lakes Area Surveying in 2020 is the accepted location of this corner.
