1914 Donner found both original Bearing Tree Stumps and noted the following accessories

Filed with the Cass County County Highway Department, Surveyors Office (CCHD/SO).

2007 Bruce W. Skipton, RLS 17768 set this corner as part of a survey in the Southwest Quarter

of Section 25, T. 140, R. 31. Certificate of Survey on file in the office of the Cass County

Highway Department.

2020 Lakes Area Surveying searched the area for all previous evidence, finding no evidence of

the original glo survey. The corner falls in a recently logged area. The 2007 Skipton pipe

was recovered and accepted for this corner.

Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument found by Lakes Area Surveying in 2020 is the accepted location of this corner.
