

In 1870, the original Government Surveyor (Black) set a post in place to mark the location of this Public Land Survey Corner with the following bearing trees:

4" Black Pine, North 86 degrees East, 15 links

4" Black Pine, South 26 degrees East, 23 links

Information on file in the MN Historical Society, St. Paul, MN and copies on file at the Cass County Highway Dept./ Surveyors Office (CCHD/SO)

In 2020, Northwestern Surveying and Engineering, Inc., a private Land Surveying and Engineering firm, was conducting cadastral surveying in this area. After research and review of historic documents and records a survey crew searched for evidence of this position. No evidence of the corner or its accessories were found.

On 9/01/2020 a crew set a ½ inch iron rebar with RLS cap stamped "Stang 52591" using lost methods. New ties were made as shown on the previous page.
