

Statement of Evidence

North Quarter corner of Section 15, Township 136 North, Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

Sept. R.Cronk, General Land Office (GLO) Deputy Surveyor, in the notes of the subdivision of Township 136
 1870 North, Range 31 West, set a post for the original corner and referenced it as follows:
 10" Aspen N 28°W 17 links
 8" Aspen S 36-1/2° E 23 links

Said records are on file with the Minnesota Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota, copies are filed with the Cass County Surveyor's Office (CCSO).

1913 John. W. Curo, Cass County Surveyor, set a 2-1/2 inch by 48 inch iron pipe monument in concrete based on a lost position. Filed in Cass County Book B, Pages 12-28, which is on file in the office of the Cass County Surveyor (Cass County Highway Department).

2003 Cass County Surveyors office found the 1913 Curo Monument, and noted the following additional accessories.

2020 Lakes Area Surveying (LAS) searched for all previous evidence, finding the 1913 Curo monument in place. Analysis of the recovered record data, field evidence and survey measurements, indicates that the monument found in November of 2020 by LAS is the accepted location of this corner
