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

- 1873 The U.S. General Land Office (GLO) survey notes and plat, on file in the MN Secretary of State's Office, describe this corner as a set post, from which:
3" Tam, N 10° W, 36 links
5" Tam, N 15° W, 50 links
- 1929 November, E.H. Juntinen found a scribed stake 2x4x48 in good condition and placed a poster on a 18" Norway, N 53° E, 0.53 chs. Do you believe the corner is genuine? Yes
Corner is in edge of swamp, ¼ chain East to high land.
- 1934 CCC Party Chief H. A. Brills, found a wooden stake in good condition, he measures, N 53° E, 0.53 chs, to a poster on a 18" N. Pine. Do you believe the corner is genuine? Yes
- 2021 June ?, Guy Carlson Itasca County Surveyor found a poster on a 20" N. Pine leaning, N 53° E, 0.53 chs and computed the corner from it.
- 2021 March, the DNR Land Survey Unit conducted a search for the corner and found the Northeast CCC bearing tree described by Juntinen, Brills and Guy Carlson. We computed the corner position per the poster data and found it to agree with Guy Carlson's position. As a result, we set the corner and tied it out. It was found to measure:

2546.189 feet (GLO = 2640 ft) from the Northeast corner section 14.
2652.906 feet (GLO = 2640 ft) from the Northeast corner section 23.

Analysis of the available information led me to accept the computed position as the corner. The found bearing tree was the best available evidence in reestablishing this corner.
