1928 Curo crews indicate chaining south between Sections 14 & 15 from the northeast corner of Section 15. The instrument was over a hub at 2581.5 South of the northeast corner of Section 15, recovered was a 2" galvanized iron monument which bears S 09° 15' E 84.00 feet from the hub. This 2" X 48" galvanized capped iron pipe was set 5 years prior by a BB Bartlett, a man from Hackensack, Minnesota, while working in Section 14-139-29 for HB Kennel. The monument was set from the original white pine bearing tree.
