General Laws, 1885, Chapter 29, as amended
General Laws, 1893, Chap. 169, allows "six legal vo-
ters who own real estate, etc., within two (2) miles of
the road to be altered, discontinued or laid out,
or eight legal voters who are freeholders and resi-
dents of the town within three (3) miles of the road
to be altered, laid out or discontinued," to sign the
petition. In the latter case, when eight or more
of such persons sign the petition, it must be so
stated on the blank line left for that purpose after
the * in the within blank.—G. S. 1894, §1806.

ROAD PETITION

To the Supervisors of the Town of May in the County of Cass
and State of Minnesota :

The undersigned, legal voters who own real estate, or who occupy real estate under the Homestead or Pre-emption Laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within two miles

of the road to be opened hereby petition you to
open a road as follows: Beginning

at the North West corner of section three(3) thence running South on the section line between sections Three (3) and Four(4) and continuing South on the section line between sections Nine (9) and Ten(10) to the South West corner of Section Ten(10), all in Township One Hundred Thirty Three(133) Range Thirty One(31), said road being two miles long.
