General Laws, 1885, Chapter 29, as amended
General Laws, 1893, Chap. 169, allows "six legal vo-
ters who own real estate, etc., within two (2) miles of
the road to be altered, discontinued or laid out,
or eight legal voters who are freeholders and resi-
dents of the town within three (3) miles of the road
petition. In the latter case, when eight or more
of such persons sign the petition, it must be so
stated on the blank line left for that purpose after
the * in the within blank.—G. S. 1894, §1806.

ROAD PETITION

To the Supervisors of the Town of May in the County of Leas and State of Minnesota :
