

State of Minnesota, County of Leas TOWN OF May SS:

Whereas, Upon the petition of Worthen (132) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate

under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who

forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed of the Stark Street corner is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at the Stark Street corner

of section three (3) thence running south
along the section line between sections 3 and 4
of township 133 north and range 103 west
and continuing southerly on the section line between
sections three (3) and ten (10) to the land of the
corner of sections ten (10) and 100 north and
thence southerly thirty three (33) range one (1)
said road being two miles long

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 5th day of June 1911 A. D. 1911, at the V. E. Barnes of section 4

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the proposed road

the same, and being of opinion that such proposed road was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying the description of which as so is as follows, to-wit: Beginning

at the North West corner of section three (3)
thence running east on the section lines
between three and four and continuing
with an N. 80° E. line between sections
three and ten, to the North West corner
of section ten; thence North and
thence North thirty three (33) range
thirty one (31) said road being two miles long

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public highway 4 rods wide
