But if no appeal is aken, or if on appeal this order is confirmed, it, together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him. Take Norrus—General Laws 1885, Chapter 20, as amended General Laws 1893, Chapter 180 allows "eight legal voters who are freeholders and residents of the town within three miles of the road" to sign the petition.
