Within five days after date of within order Town Board shall make its Award of Damages and file all papers pertaining to the road with the Town Clerk. The Town Clerk must not record this order within thirty days after filing, and not to record it in appeal has been taken, until the order is confirmed on appeal. If no appeal is taken or if on appeal this order is confirmed, it together with the award and damages shall be transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.

State of Minnesota, County of Cass Town of Moose Lake ss:

Whereas, Upon the petition of eight legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed Road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at north end of road, between

sections 15 and 16, Twp 136 R 31, thence running north on section line to corner stake of the north east corner of section 4 and NE corner of section three and terminating thereat

The center line of said road to follow and coincide with section line running between sections 16, 9 and 4 and sections 15, 10 and 3 respectively Twp 136 R 31 as near as practicable, said road to be of the width of four rods, i.e. two rods on each side of said section line

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 15th day of June 1920, at 10 o'clock in the afternoon at the residence of Sylvester Fairley

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants; proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such roads, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the laying out and establishing

the same, and being of opinion that such proposed road was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out and establish said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so described is as follows, to-wit: Beginning

At north end of road lying between sections no. 15 and 16 Twp 136 R 31 thence running in a northerly direction following the section line to corner stake of the NE corner section 4 and NE corner sect 3 Twp 136 R 31 and terminating thereat.

The center line of said road following and to coincide with section line lying between sections 16, 9 and 4 and 15, 10 and 3 respectively Twp 136 R 31 as near as practicable.

Said road shall be and is four rods wide i.e. two rods on each side of said section line

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public road four rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.
