State of Minnesota, County of Cass Town of Crooked Lake ss:

Whereas, Upon the petition of eight legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be vacated; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed vacation is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

a strip of land 66 feet in width and being 33 feet on each side of the following described centerline to-wit: Beginning at a point in the West line of Section 24, Township 139 North Range 26 West a distance of 625 feet South of North West corner of said Section 24, thence north along the West line of said Section 24 a distance of 625 feet to the Northwest corner thereof, thence East along the North line of said Section 24 to a point 1437 feet West of the North one-quarter corner of said Section 24, it being the intention to vacate not only the present road as it is described on the records, but also the road as it is now traveled, and which runs in a north westerly direction, after leaving the section line north of the above described point of beginning, thence to the West and north of the pot hole or swamp in which the Northwest corner of Section 24 is located, and thence in a southwesterly direction back to the North line of said Section 24 and thence East along the North line of said Section 24 to the point above described, as being 1437 feet West of the North one-quarter corner of Sec. 24.

And also the following a strip of land 66 feet in width and being 33 feet on each side of the following described centerline to-wit: Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 23, Township 139 North Range 26 West, and running thence West along the North line of Section 23 a distance of 706 feet.

State of Minnesota, County of Cass Town of Grouted Lake ss:

Whereas, Upon the petition of eight legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed new road is set forth

and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning a strip of land 66ft. in width and being 33ft. on each side of the following described centerline to-wit: beginning at a point in the West Side of section 24 a distance of 1010ft. north of the West one quarter corner of said section; thence North 56 degrees and 30. minutes East a distance of 5115 feet; thence North 42 degrees and 00 minutes East a distance of 900 feet; thence North 14 degrees and 00 minutes East a distance of 666 feet, terminating at a point in the north line of section 24 distant 14137 feet West of the north one quarter corner thereof, all in Township 139 North, Range 26 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 22nd day of October 1928, at Clerk's Office at Roswell Lake

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such road might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such road, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the laying out the same, and being of opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit: Beginning the same as above.

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public road four rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road.

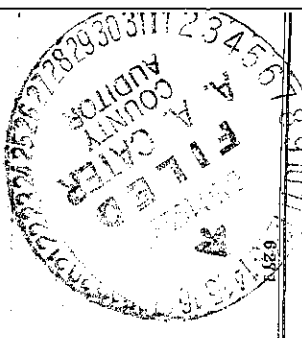

Within five days after date of within order Town Board shall file its Award of Damages and file all papers pertaining to the road with the Town Clerk. The Town Clerk must not record this order within thirty days after filing, and not then, if an appeal has been taken, until the appeal is confirmed on appeal. But if no appeal is taken, or if on appeal this order is confirmed in, together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.
