Within five days after date of within order Town Board shall make its award of Damages and file all papers pertaining to the road with the Town Clerk. The Town Clerk must not record this order within thirty days after filing, and not then, if an appeal has been taken, until the order is confirmed on appeal. But if no appeal is taken, or if on appeal this order is confirmed, it, together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.

State of Minnesota, County of Cass Town of Paste Lake SS:

Whereas, Upon the petition of Eight legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the ~~road~~ ^{cutway} proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed cutway is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at the South East Corner of

Section thirty one (31) and Southwest Corner of Section thirty two (32) thence running north on Section line between said Sections 31 and 32 and quarter of a mile to the South East Corner of lot six (6) Section thirty one (31) and the South West Corner of the North West quarter of the South West quarter of Section thirty two (32) all in town ship one hundred thirty nine (139) north of range twenty nine West, and there terminate

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 14th day of July A. D. 1917, at South East Corner of lot 6 Section 31

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the laying out and opening up the same, and being of opinion that such cutway was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said ~~road~~ ^{cutway}, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit: Beginning

It is Therefore Ordered and Determined, That a ~~road~~ ^{cutway} be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is declared to be a public-highway two (2) rods wide the said description above given being the center of said ~~road~~ ^{cutway}.

State of Minnesota, County of Cass Town of Paulta Lake SS:

Whereas, A ^{Cutway} road was laid out on the 14th day of July, A. D. 1917, by us, the Supervisors of the said Town of Paulta Lake on the petition of Eight legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of said ^{Cutway} road, which said road as laid out ^{Cutway} is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors' Order, made by us, and

Whereas, A part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out and opening up ^{Cutway} said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said ^{Cutway} road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said ^{Cutway} road passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which such ^{Cutway} road passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the benefits the ^{Cutway} road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages. We have assessed and awarded damages as follows:
