But if no appeal is taken, or if on appeal this order is affirmed, it together with the award must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.

State of Minnesota, County of Cass Town of Ponto Lake SS:

Whereas, Upon the petition of Fifteen (15) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk, who forthwith presented it to us for action thereon, and which said proposed road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at the South East Corner of Section

Twenty five, Township One Hundred thirty nine, Range Twenty nine,
thence running West to the quarter corner between Sections twenty
three and twenty six, thence South one hundred sixty rods to the Center
of Section twenty six, thence West one hundred sixty rods to the section
line between Sections twenty six and twenty seven, thence South on the
section line to the South East corner of the North East quarter of the
North East quarter of Section thirty four, thence West one mile to the
South West corner of the North West quarter of the North West quarter
Section 34, thence running South two hundred forty rods on section
line between Sections thirty three and thirty four to the South East
corner of Section thirty three and the South West corner of Section
thirty four and there terminate

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out an order or notice of hearing and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and act upon said petition, to-wit: On the 10th day of November A. D. 1917, at J. W. Johnsons place in Section 25

causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days before such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the petitioners had, at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally upon each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard all persons interested, and any and all reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and being of opinion that such road was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, and caused a survey thereof to be made according to the report and plat herewith accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit: Beginning

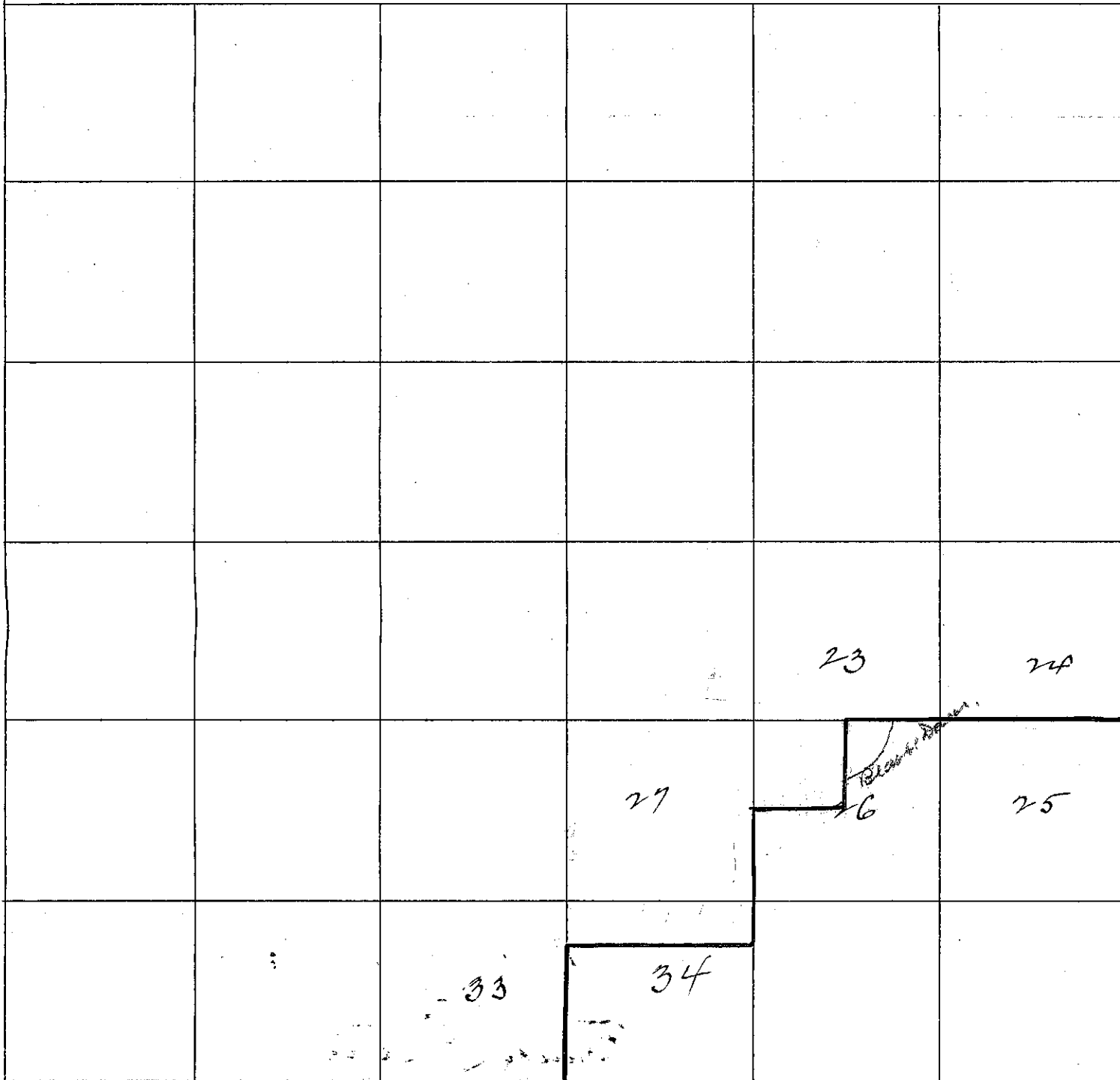

State of Minnesota, County of Cass Town of Panta Lake SS:

Whereas, A road was laid out..... on the 10th day of November A. D. 1917, by us, the Supervisors of the said Town of Panta Lake on the petition of giftans legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of said road, which said road..... as laid out is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors' Order, made by us, and

Whereas, A part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out..... of said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said road passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which such road passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages. We have assessed and awarded damages as follows:
