causing copies of such notice to be
posted in three public places in
said town at least ten days before
such meeting and having met at
such time and place as above
named in said ^{notice} petition and
being satisfied that the
petitioners had at least ten days
previous to said time caused said
notice of time and place of hearing
to be given to all the occupants
of the land through which such
high way might pass by. serving the
same personally upon each of said
occupants. proof of said which was
shown by affidavit we proceeded
to examine personally such
highway and heard any and all

Whereas upon the petition of (eight)
legal voters, who own real estate, or who
own or occupy real estate under the homestead
or pre-emption laws of the United States
or under contract from the state of
Minnesota within three miles of the
road proposed in said petition to
be laid out which said petition
was filed with the town clerk
who forthwith presented it to us for
action thereon and which proposed
new road is set forth and
described in attached petition
and whereas upon receiving said
petition we did within thirty
days thereafter make out an order
or notice of hearing and fix
therein a time and place at which
we would meet and act upon

(The same)

reasons for or against the laying
and being of the opinion that such laying
out was necessary and proper
and that the public interest
would be promoted thereby, we
granted the prayer of petitioners
and determined to lay ^{out} said road
according to the report and petition
herewith accompanied

It is therefore ordered and
determined that a road be and
the same is hereby laid out
according to the description in
petition and the accompanying Report
and petition which is hereby made
a part of this order, and it is
declared to be a public highway
four rods wide the description
in petition being the center of said road
given under our hands
