Whereas, A road was laid out and established on the 7th day of October 1922, by us, the Supervisors of the said Town of Shingabeer on the petition of eight legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within three (3) miles of said road, which said road

is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors' Order, made by us, and Whereas, ~~part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out~~ ~~of the road~~ ~~has~~ ~~been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages that not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said road passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands having withdrawn, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the owners of such lands through which said road passes as unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages. We have assessed and awarded damages as follows:~~
