Within five days after date or within order Town Board shall make its Avard of Damages and file all papers pertaining to the road with the Town Clerk.

The Town Clerk must not record this order within thirty days after filing, and not then, if an appeal has been taken, until the order is confirmed on appeal. But if no appeal is confirmed, it, together with the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the the award, must be recorded and then transmitted to the County Auditor, to be filed and preserved by him.
