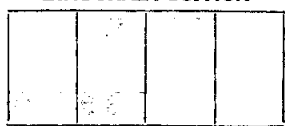
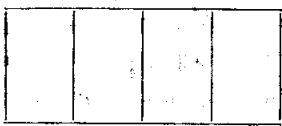

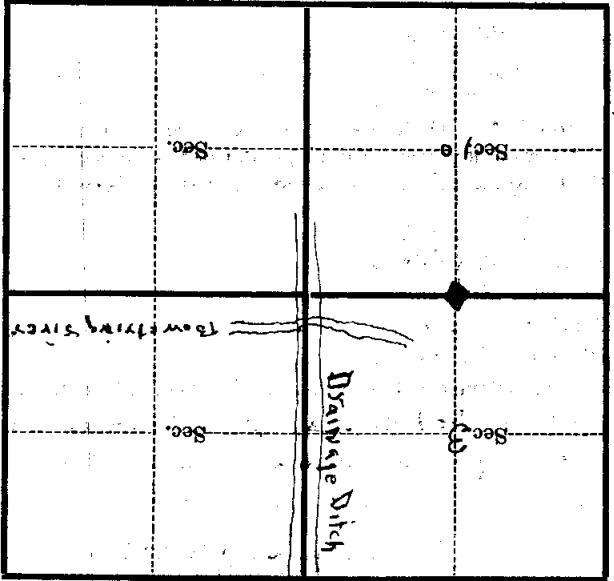

 The name W. F. H. 1912 was plainly visible  
 but rest of writing indistinguishable  
 They had also blazed a 14" Balm.  
 Largest blazes: 12" Birch snag 53° E 22 1/2 Ks  
 19" Balm 54° W 24 1/2 Ks

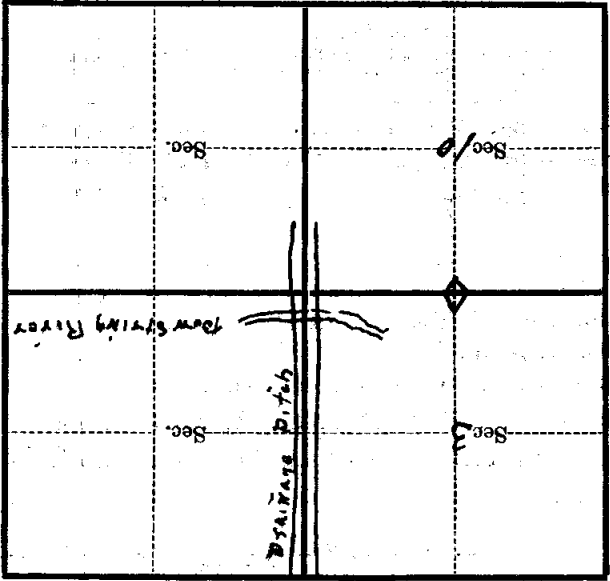

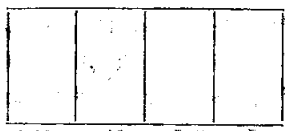

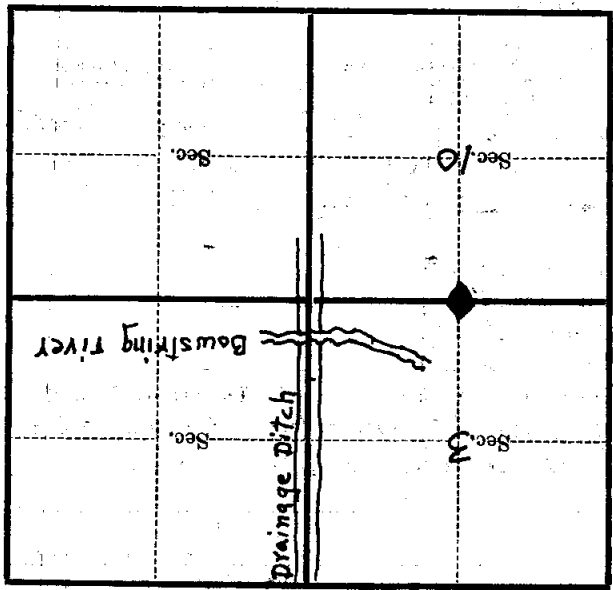

Give any further facts which will aid in finding this corner again. *Another metal location poster on 4" Balm of Gilead from which this corner bears N60°W., 13 chains. This Balm also has 2 flags facing corner. Current has flowed and marked a Pick snag facing corner. The name "U. S. Flint, 1912" was plainly visible, but rest of writing indistinguishable. They had also flowed a 14" Balam. Bearings & distances:*

12" Birch snag S37°E 23 links  
 14" Balam S42°W 29 links

Metal Location Poster is on a *oak* tree 3 inches diameter, on the SE side of *tree*.  
 From which this Corner bears S73°E  
 chains distant. *oak also has 2 flags*
