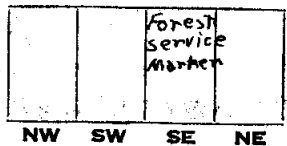
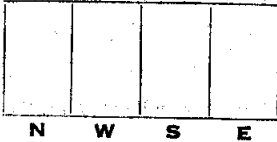

CARDINAL POSITION

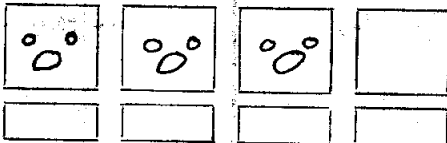

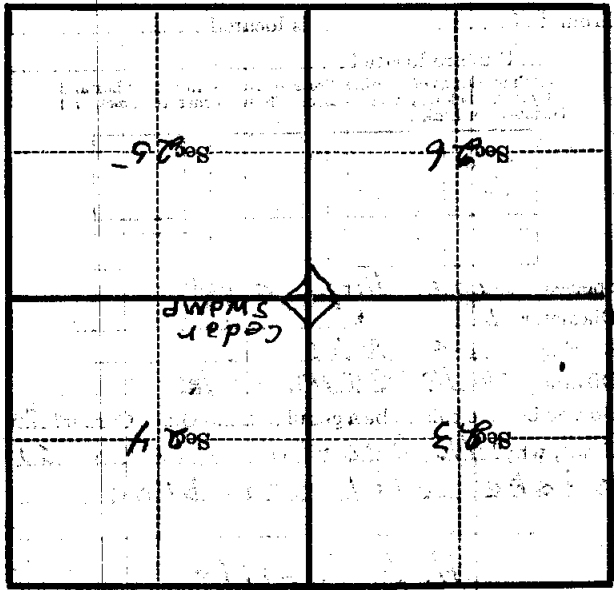
