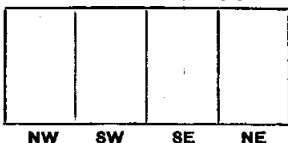
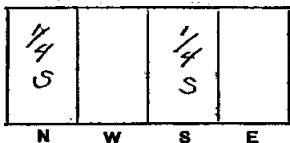

CARDINAL POSITION

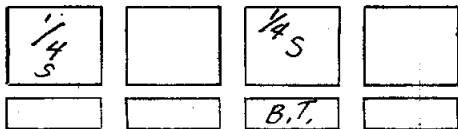
DIAGONAL POSITION

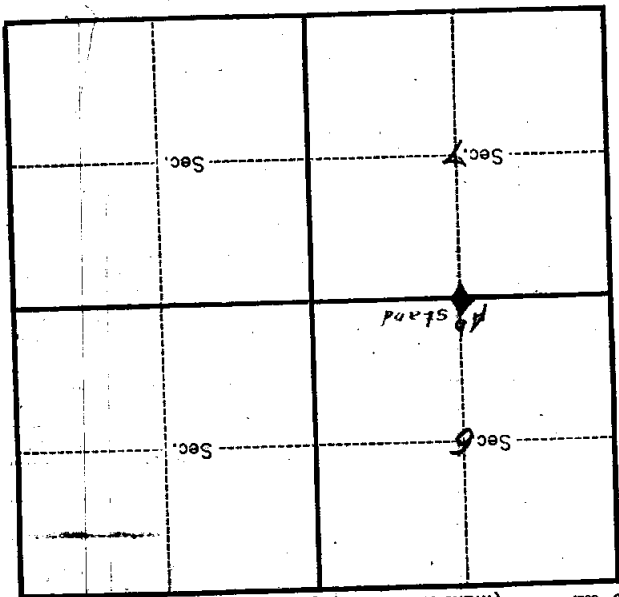
